

## LEVEL 2

Programs with the following criteria in place have achieved Level 2:

- **A formal written policy describing tobacco use practices for staff and persons served.**
- **Tobacco use is included in the program’s welcoming statement and there is onsite signage and resources available for persons served.**
- **The program has tobacco-free entryways (minimum of 20 ft.).**
